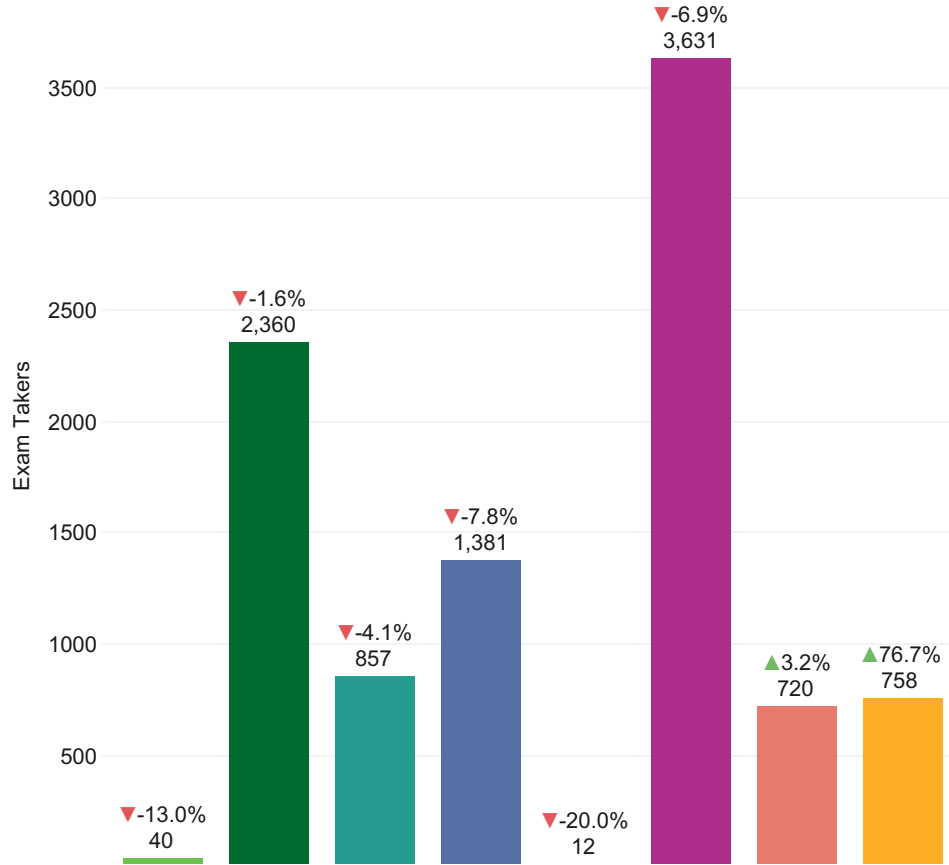

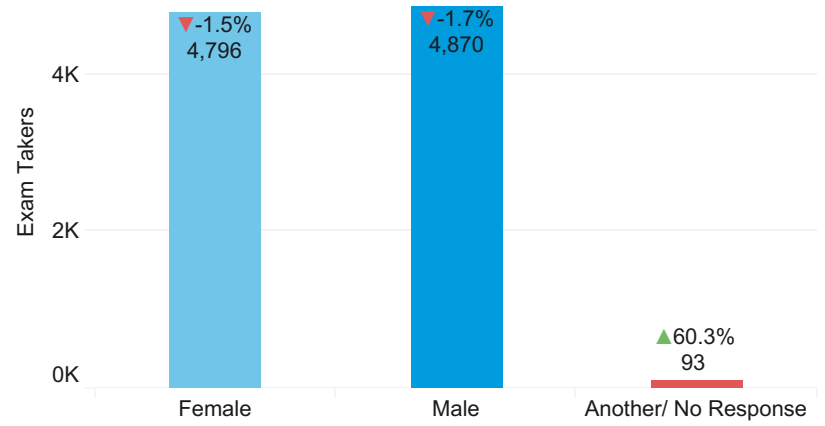

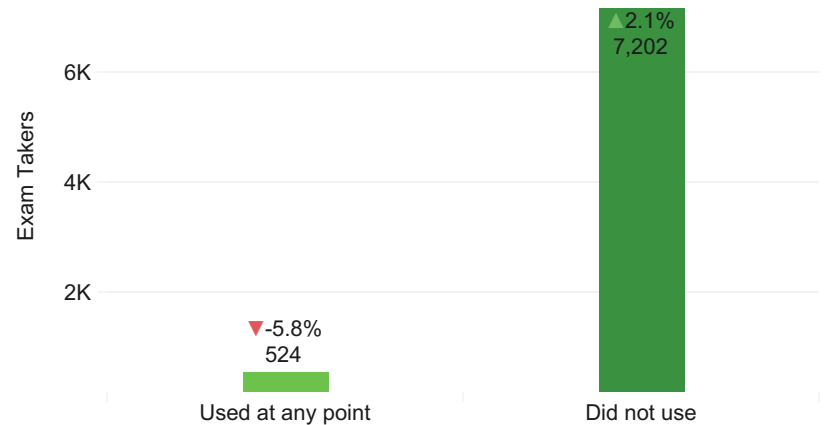
Participation by Gender

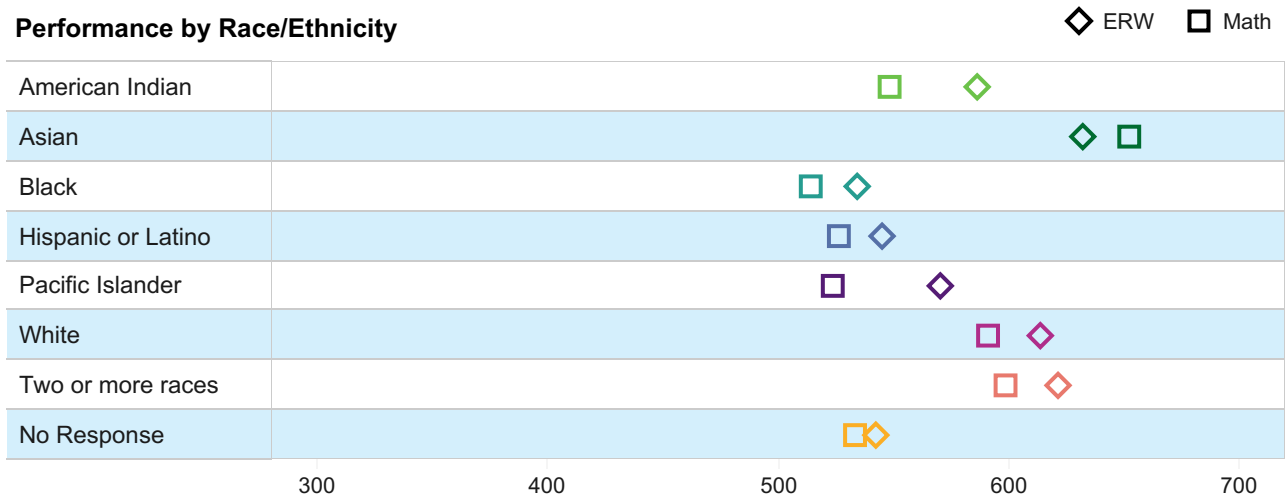

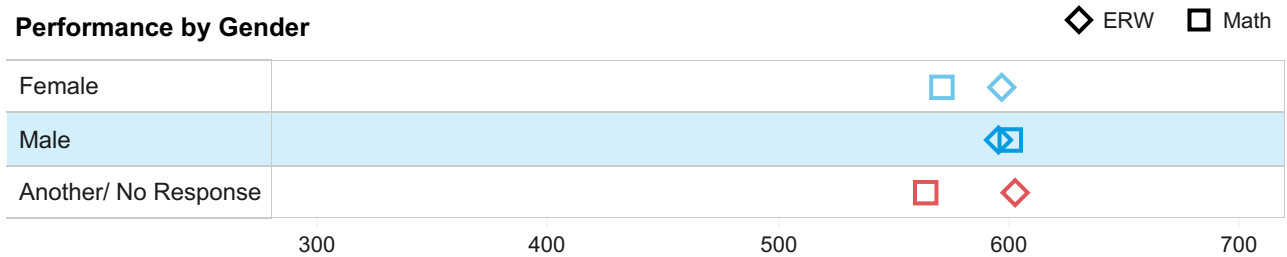

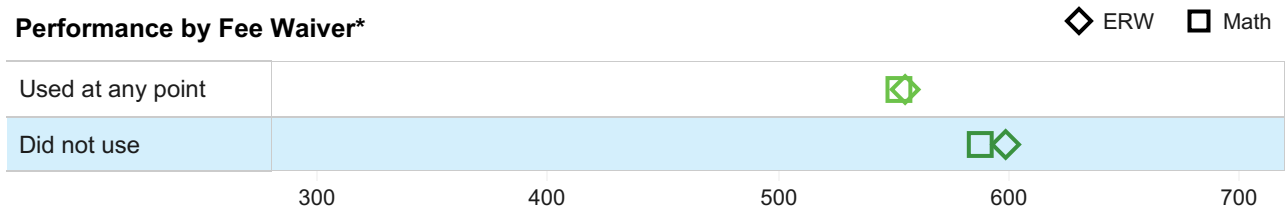

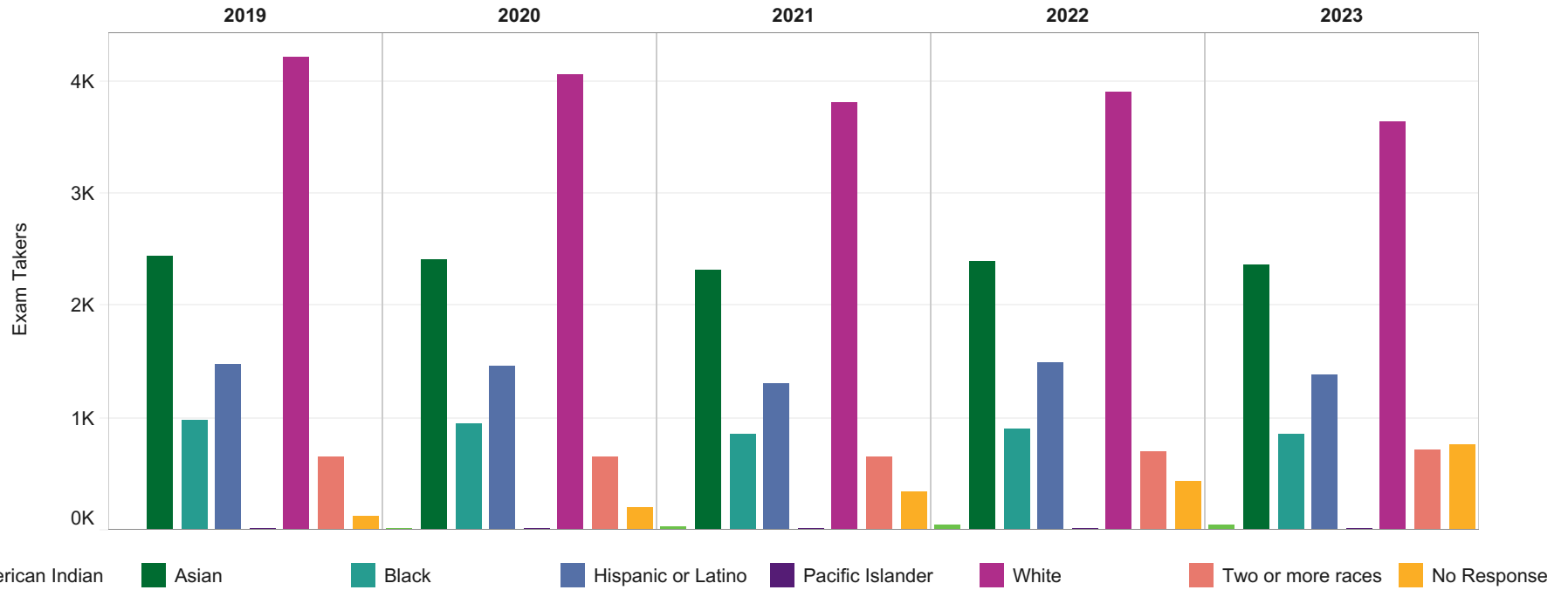

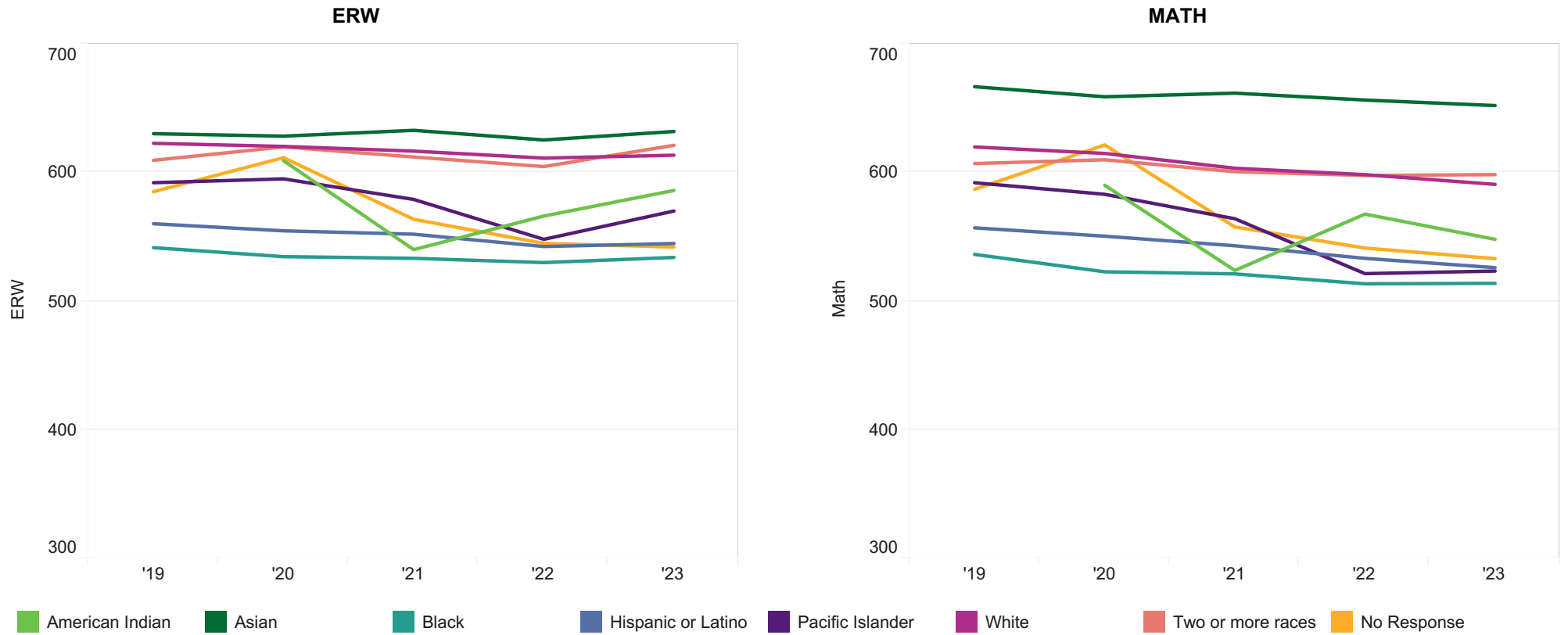

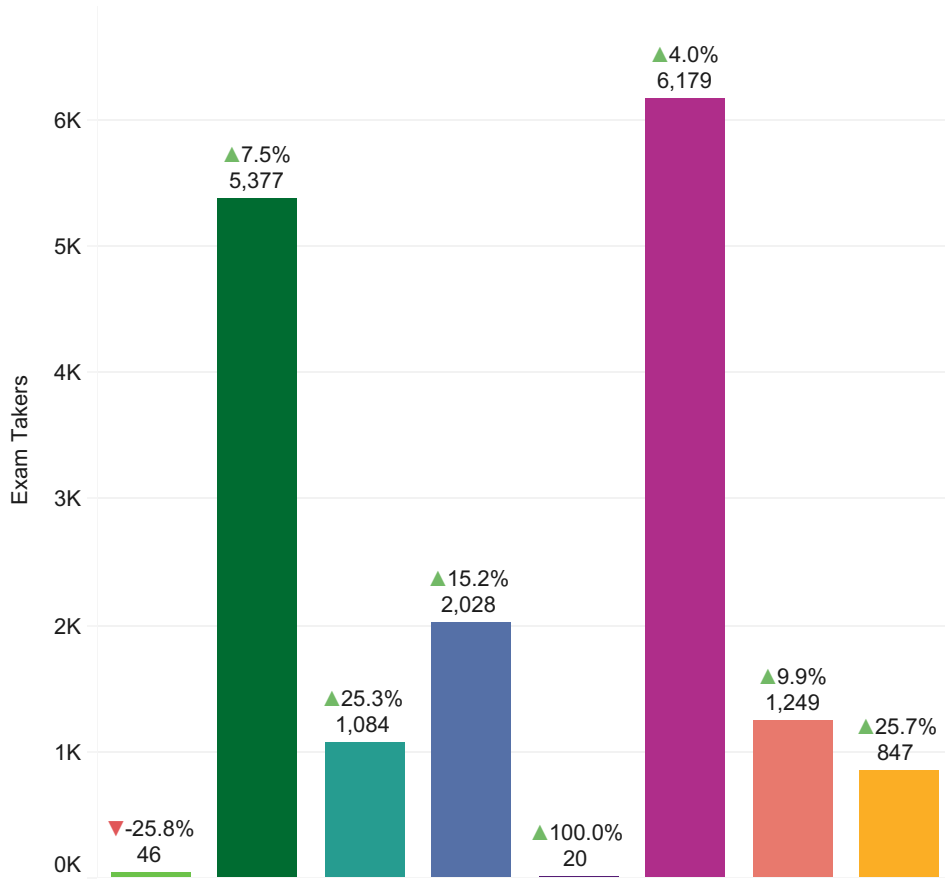

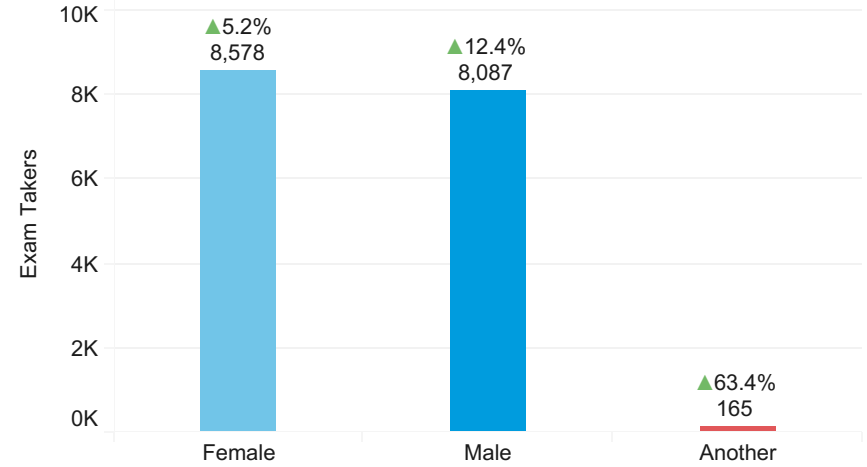

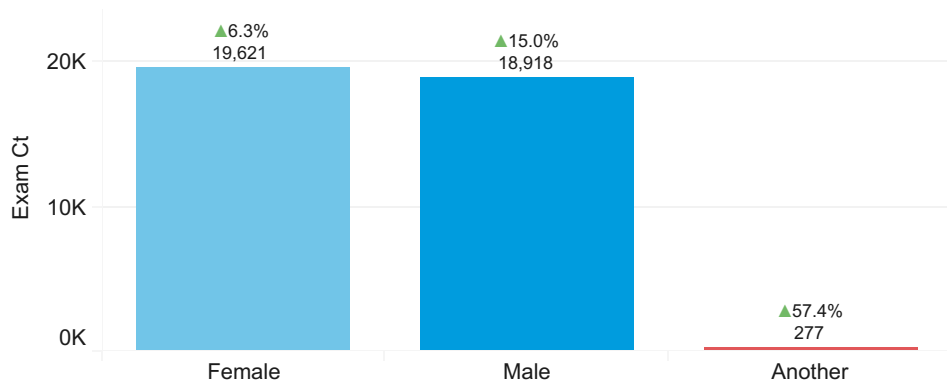

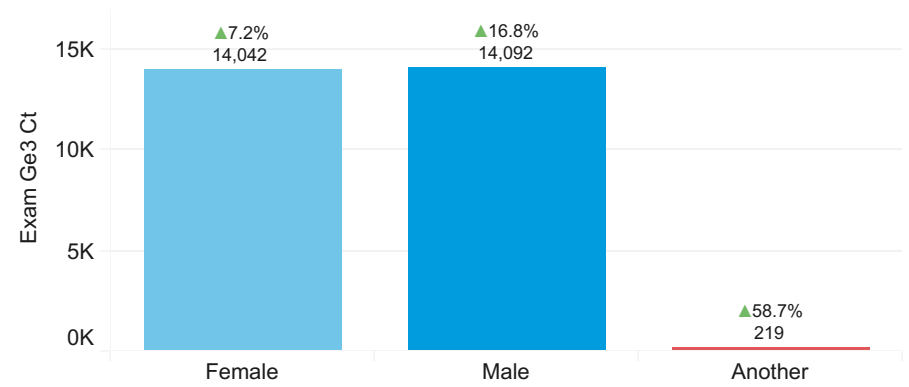

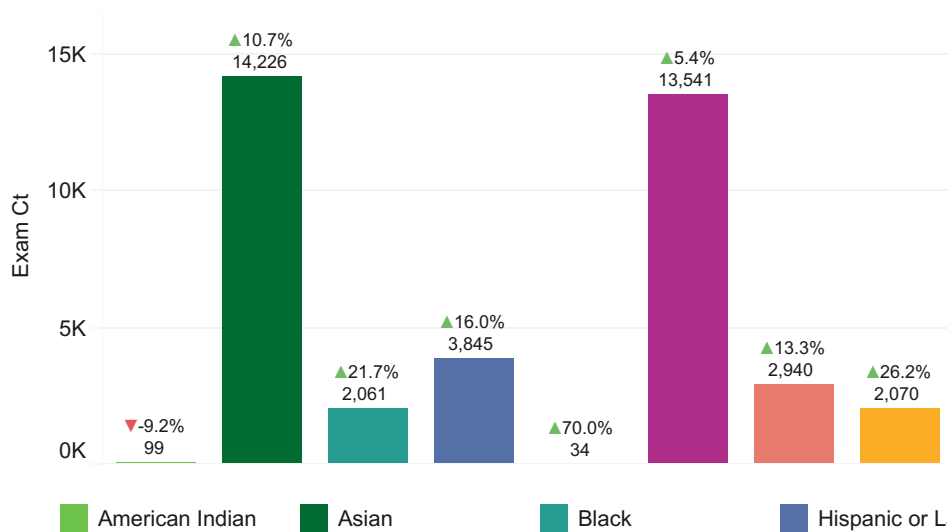
AP Exams Taken by Gender



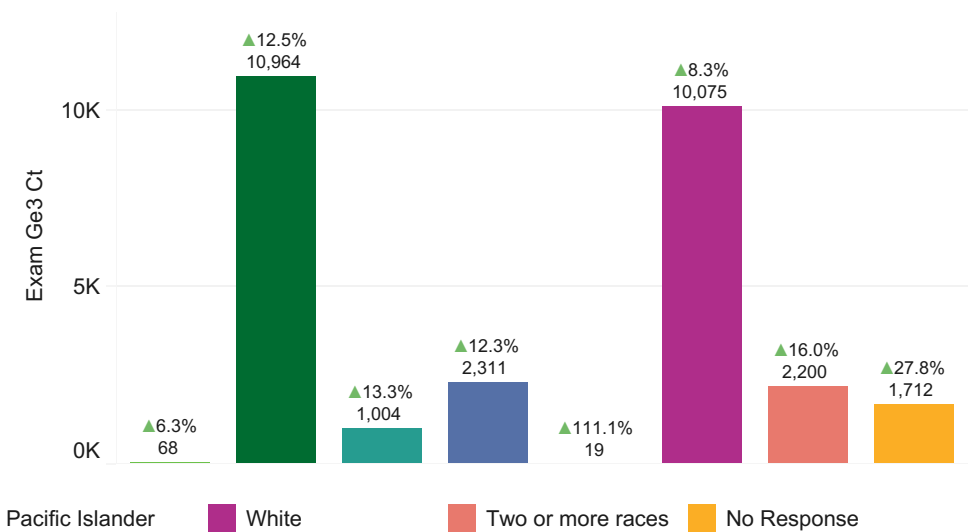
AP Exams with Grade 3,4 or 5 by Gender



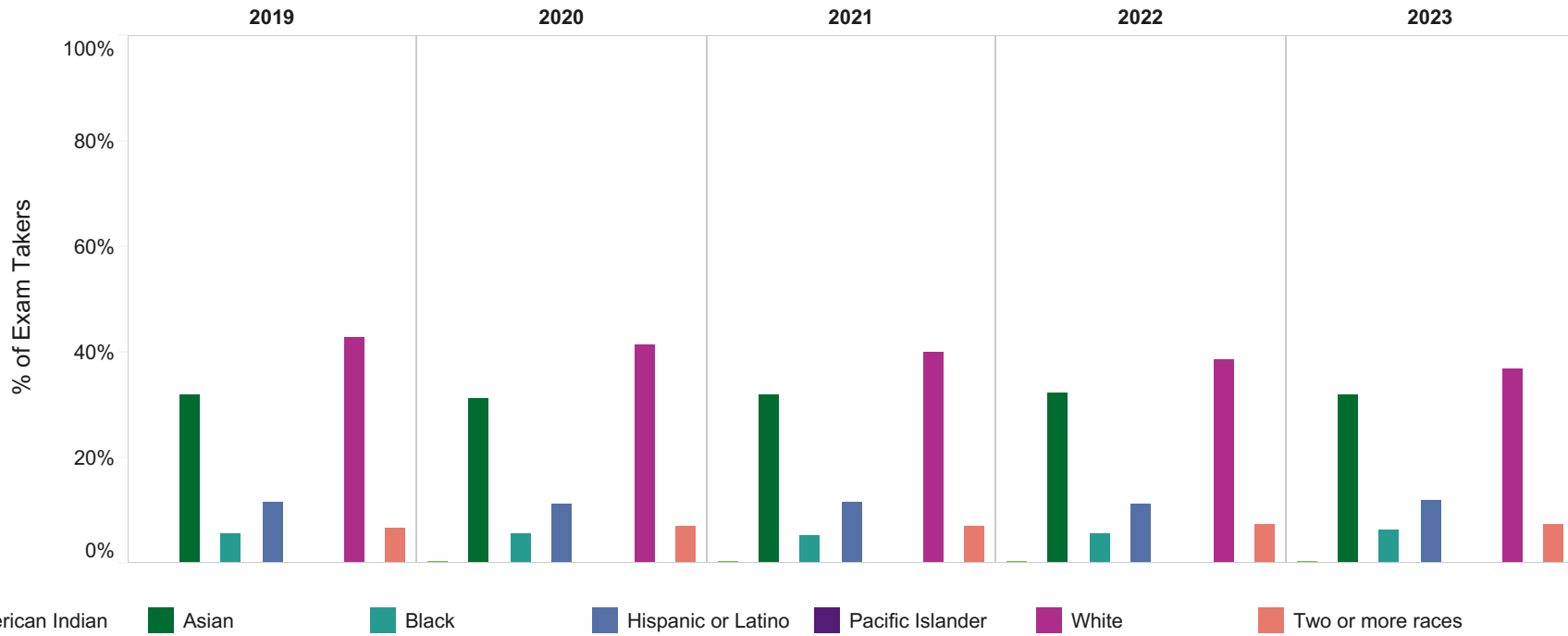
AP Exams Taken by Race/Ethnicity



AP Exams with Grade 3,4 or 5 by Race/Ethnicity

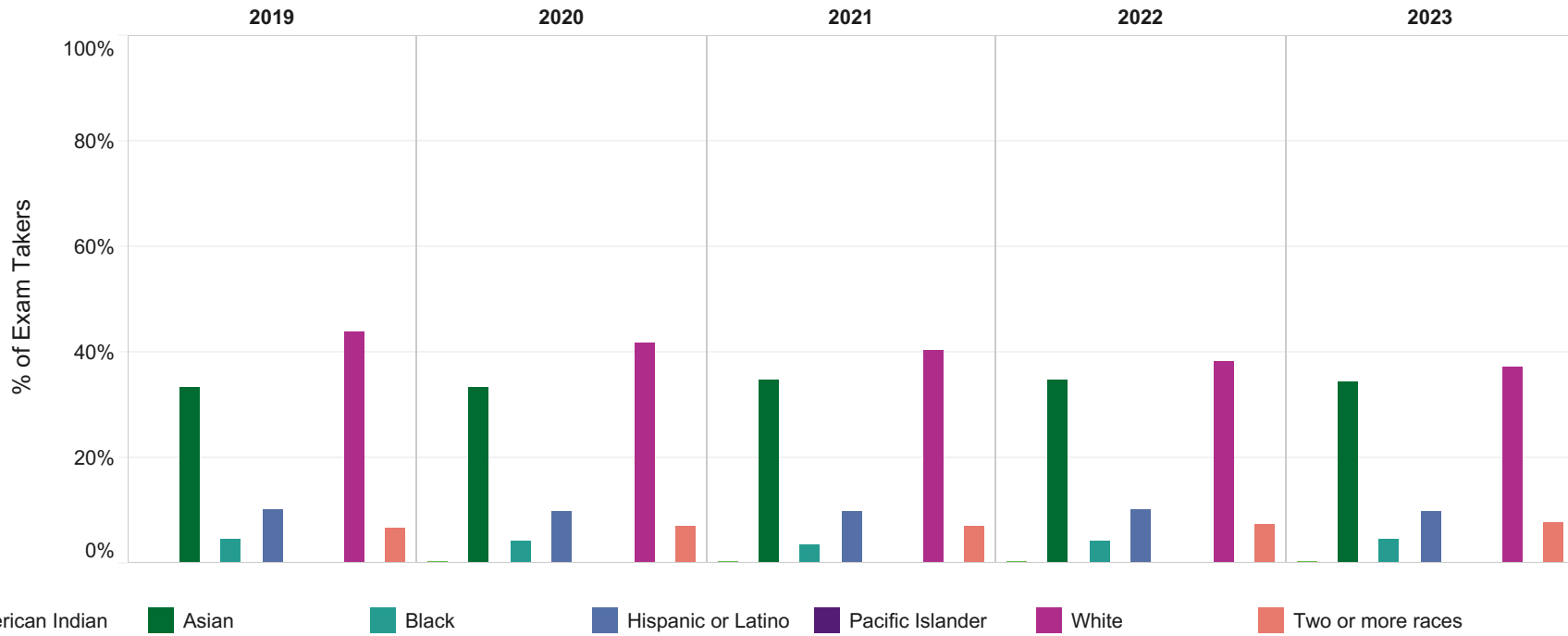

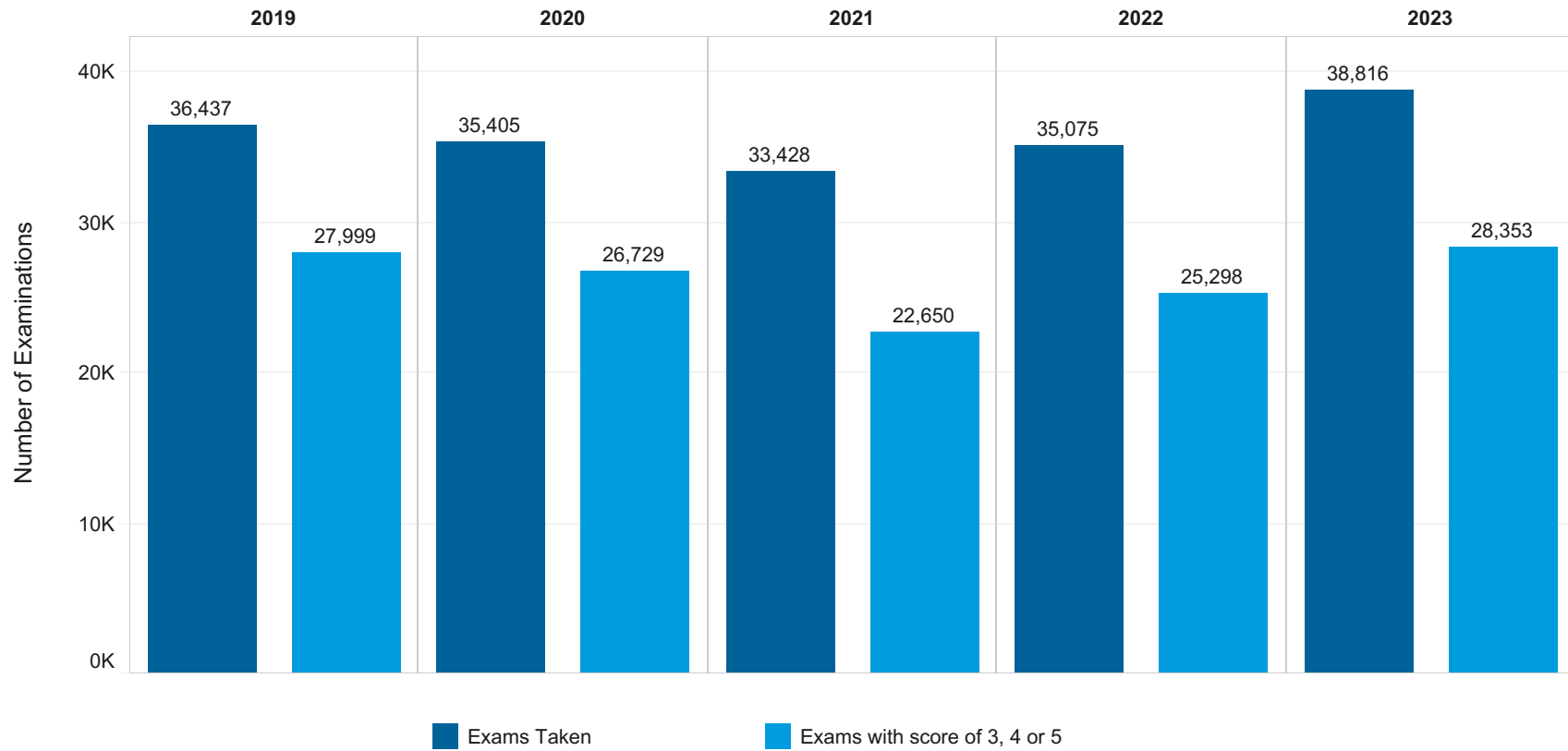

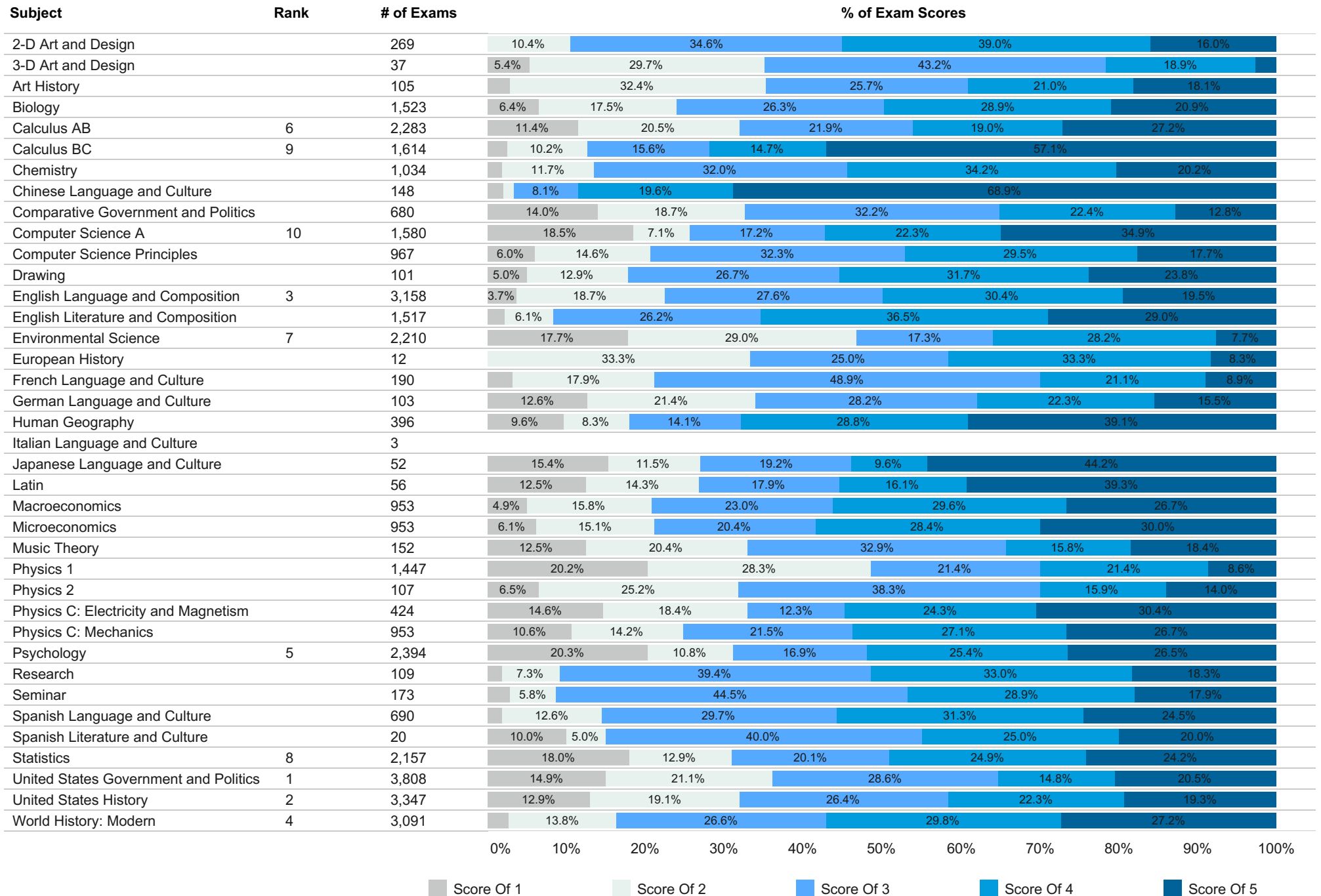

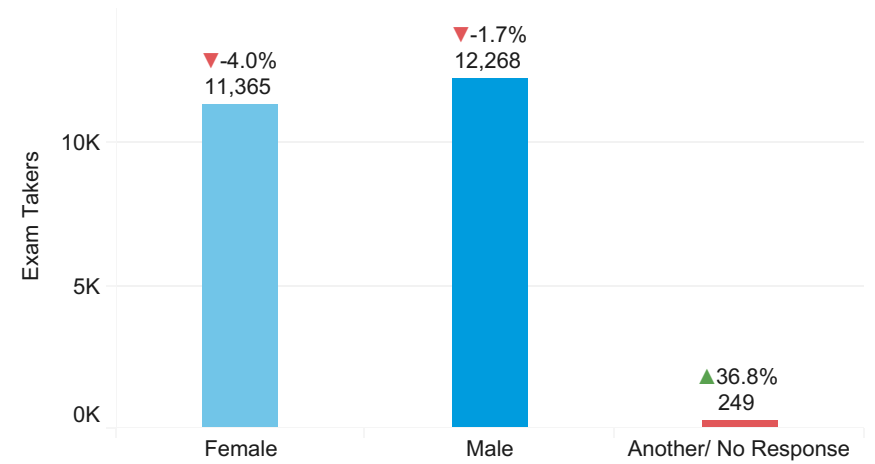

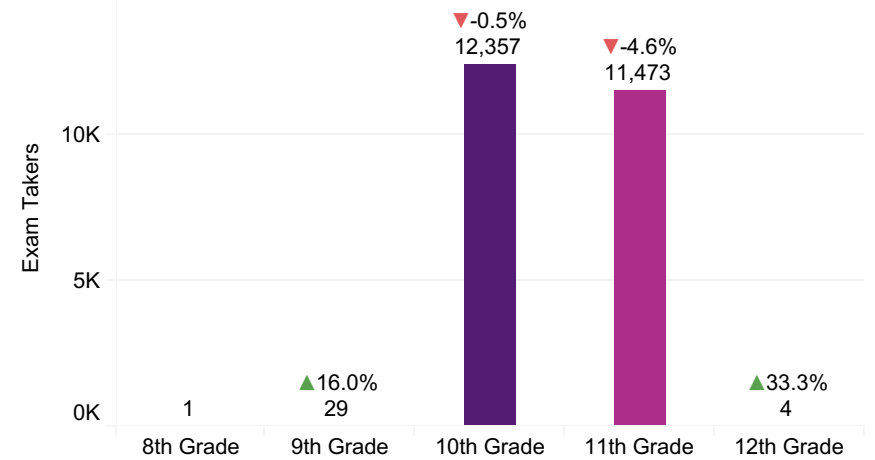
Participation by Gender

Participation By Grade Level



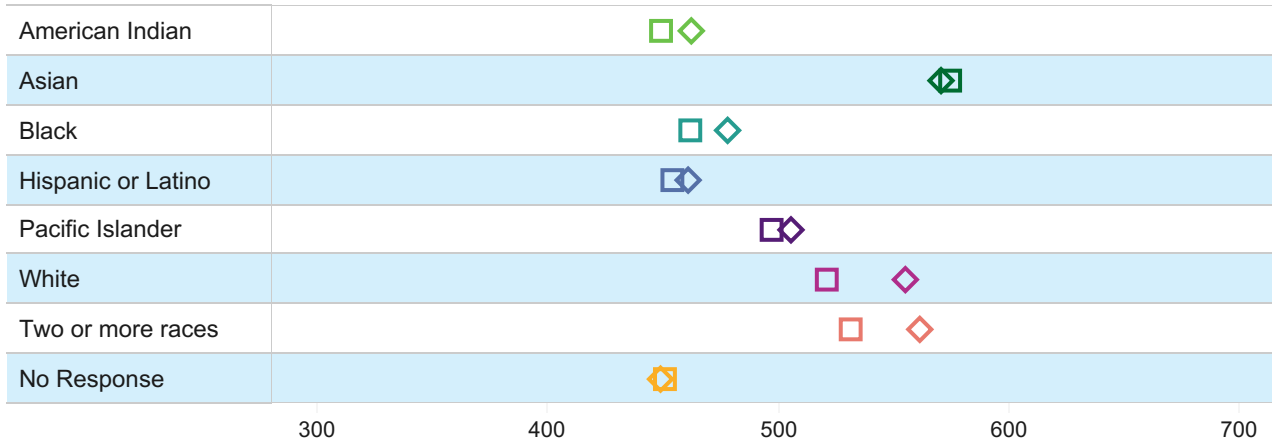

Participation By Grade Level



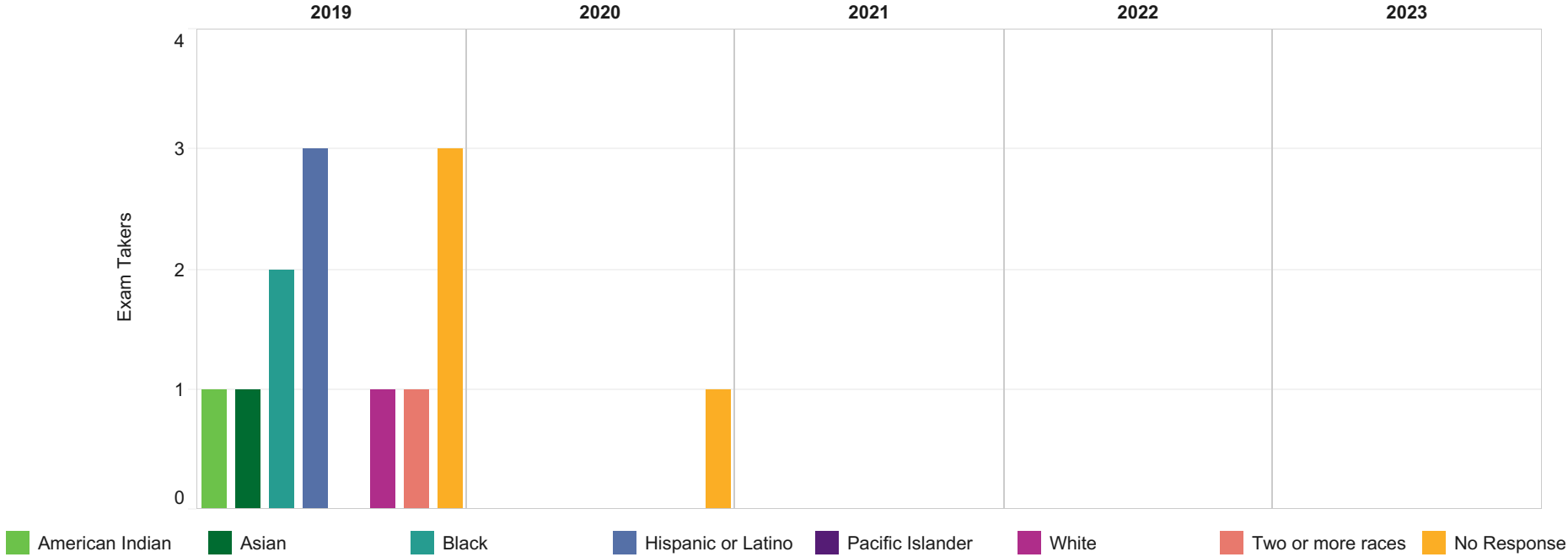

Data Notes

SAT Participation and Performance: Data reflect SAT test activity for students who graduated high school in 2023. If a student took the SAT more than once, the most recent score is summarized. SAT data contained in this report reflect frozen snapshots of College Board's integrated data system as of mid-July after each respective class graduated. Thus results may differ slightly from analyses run at other points in time or based on different population definitions.

AP Participation and Performance: AP Exams are administered at the end of each school year. Statistical Information about AP Exam takers is based on all students taking AP for each year reported. AP Data contained in this report reflect a frozen snapshot of each academic year 's AP exam results as taken in mid-July of that year.

PSAT-related Assessments Participation and Performance: Data reflect students who took PSAT/NMSQT and/or PSAT 10, or students who took PSAT 8/9 during the 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 or 2022-23 school years. If a student tested more than once within an academic year and assessment (e.g., took PSAT/NMSQT in fall and then PSAT 10 in spring; or a student who took PSAT 8/9 in both fall and spring of particular school year), the most recent score and self-reported questionnaire responses are summarized.

Mean Scores: Throughout this report, mean scores are only reported for populations consisting of at least ten students.

Racial/Ethnic Background: College Board is the source for examinee race/ethnicity. College Board follows federal guidelines regarding collection of race/ethnicity data. Aggregate race/ethnicity derived from two separate questions that students respond to; see here: https://nces.ed.gov/programs/handbook/data/pdf/appendix_a.pdf

Note the following regarding abbreviations of the reporting categories - American Indian includes Alaska Native, Black includes African American, and Pacific Islander includes Native Hawaiian. Although "Other" as an option has been discontinued it may continue to be reported for historical reporting purposes. Students who are reported as "Two or more races" are non-Hispanic. Hispanic includes all students who self-identified as Cuban; Mexican; Puerto Rican; or Another Hispanic, Latino, or Latin American on the ethnicity portion of the race/ethnicity questionnaire.

American Indian Self-Identification: Data describing American Indian student participation should be interpreted cautiously. Changes to collection of student data made between 2019 and 2020 increased the rate of students mistakenly self-selecting Native American or Alaska Native, impacting reported values for 2021 and 2022 in this report. A tribal affiliation field has been added to improve reportable data for future reports.

Change from Last Year: The change from last year for frequency data (number of test-takers or exams) is represented as a percentage change. It is obtained by subtracting the previous year's total from the current year and then dividing this difference by the previous year's total, which is then multiplied by 100.

Framing AP Score Distributions: Students take rigorous AP® courses in high school, in part, for the chance to earn college credit and placement through a score of 3 or higher on the exam. Evidence also shows there are benefits to taking AP courses even for students who don't meet that threshold. Many students who first score a 1 or 2 on an AP Exam will take further AP courses and score higher. Further, AP students who earn a score of 1 or 2, or average a score of 1 or 2 across their AP Exams in high school, have better college outcomes than academically similar college students who did not take an AP course and exam.

2020 AP Exams: Because of pandemic disruptions, 2020 AP exams were abbreviated (e.g., no multiple choice, all free response), which enabled millions of students to test on cellphones and other devices while quarantining at home. Accordingly, the full-length 2019 AP exams are the appropriate comparison to the 2021, 2022, and 2023 AP exams.

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
