




STOP RAISING TAXES!

Set the tax rate at \$1.08!

The Fairfax County supervisors are deciding on next year's tax rate.

To prevent a tax increase due to a 4% increase in residential assessments, the supervisors must set next year's tax rate at \$1.08 instead of continuing the current tax rate of \$1.1225!



For 25 years, the Fairfax County real estate taxes have been **increasing 3 times faster than household income**

What do we get in return?

- A 35-point drop in Fairfax County Public Schools SAT scores since 2019.
- An 82-point drop in TJ SAT scores in 2025.
- **Unaffordable housing** due to spiraling real estate taxes.
- A business-hostile government (**slow permitting**, and **restaurants must pay 14 taxes**).
